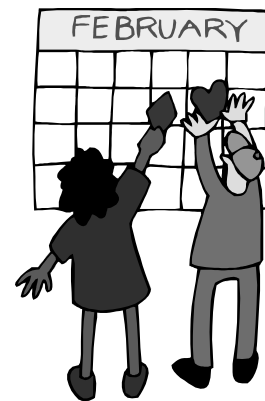

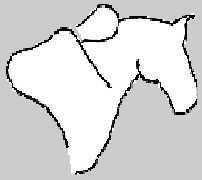

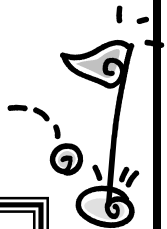
Ω EAT's 4th Annual Golf Tournament Ω

Reservations are limited so get your foursome together for a great day on the links and benefit our awesome program while you're at it!

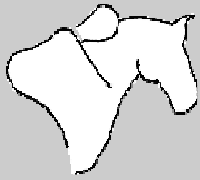
